But with the word of God it is a baptism, that is, a life-giving water, rich in grace, and a washing of the new birth in the Holy Spirit, as St. Paul says in Titus, chapter three:
He saved us through the washing of rebirth [Kindergarten +]
and renewal by the Holy Spirit,
whom He poured out on us generously [First Grade +]
through Jesus Christ our Savior,
so that, having been justified by His grace, [Second Grade +]
we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life.
This is a trustworthy saying. *Titus 3:5-8*
