- Bible Verse of the Week*** – Proverbs 28:13 (ESV) [Preschool +]
Whoever conceals his transgressions will not prosper, but he who confesses and forsakes them will obtain mercy.

***Catechism Memory Work* – CONFESSION**

- What is Confession?*** [Kindergarten +]
Confession has two parts.
First that we confess our sins,
and second, that we receive absolution,
that is, forgiveness, from the pastor as from God Himself,
not doubting, but firmly believing that by it our sins are forgiven
before God in heaven.
- What sins should we confess?*** [Second Grade +]
Before God we should plead guilty of all sins,
even those we are not aware of, as we do in the Lord’s Prayer;
but before the pastor we should confess only those sins
which we know and feel in our hearts.
