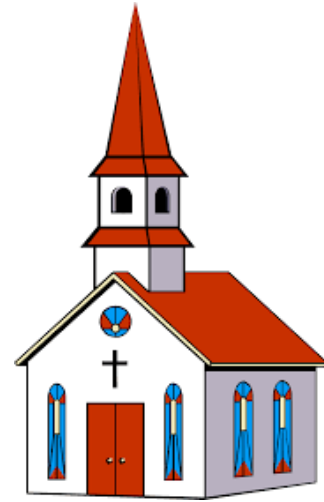
## ***Making a Joyful Noise***
