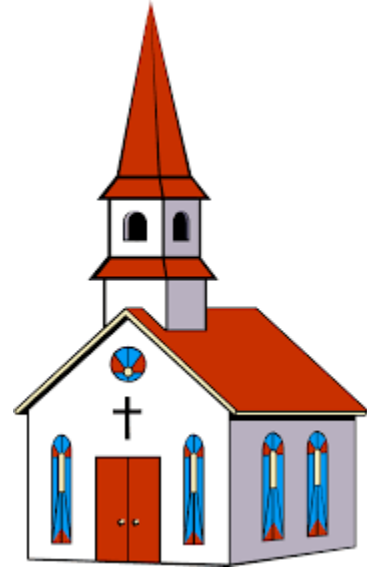
Making a Joyful Noise
