Making a Joyful Noise

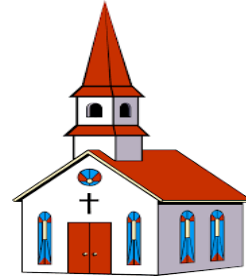
