The tentative 2024schedule for our projects is:


March 2024 – an event for Hope House

The Ecumenical Food Pantry of Blairsville will distribute Easter food baskets for 160 households in need.


Our goal is to supply 160 gallons of milk! Bring your "milk money" to Lenten Suppers or on Sunday and help reach the goal.
