Hello Church Family,


And by Church Family, I mean ALL of us--Asbury Memorial and Wesley Oak Churches! One year after Asbury Memorial's disaffiliation, I'm delighted to announce that Wesley Oak is now disaffiliated, too, and we are officially merged to be partners in the ministry of Jesus Christ.

Please note I chose my words carefully. We are officially merged—documents are signed, notarized and filed with the appropriate governmental agencies—but we are just on the cusp of being practically merged: administrative systems are being combined, property use and care are coming together and leaders from both churches are meeting regularly to learn each other's histories, to evaluate the good that's happening now and to listen for the Holy Spirit to show us how to announce and invite the kingdom of God into this beautiful, yet challenged, city we call our home.

Planning a future in an uncertain time takes all the love and faith with which we are blessed. In some ways it seems harder and in others it gives us more space and time to be curious, to feel deeply and to think broadly. To me, it feels as if we're enclosed in a chrysalis, waiting for God's perfect time to emerge transformed to serve God through loving our neighbors.

During this time of discernment, I humbly ask you to continue to do what you have always done: to pray for our churches and its leaders. To attend worship in whichever sanctuary or through whichever media suits your needs best. To continue your support and to help when you are asked. Who could have imagined this a few years ago? Not me! But I'm excited about our future because I know that when we follow God's lead and hold God's people in our hearts, we are blessed to be a blessing in God's world.

Dear Asbury Family,

I have enjoyed your love, support and community for three years now and I wanted to say thank you. Our time together and our shared mission is very important to me, and John and I are grateful for our church family.

John has been recently diagnosed with advanced Mantle Cell Lymphoma (MCL), a blood cancer. He is feeling well overall, just fatigued. However, his immune system is highly compromised, which is scary at this time when Covid-19 is running rampant.

This has come as a shock to us and the last month has been a whirlwind of processing a lot of new information and emotions. We have found an outstanding care team at MD Anderson and are very hopeful about his treatment and prognosis. **The most intensive part of John's therapy will be coming up in September and October.**

I will be taking a leave of absence starting on Monday, August 23, 2021 and plan to return to our church work on Monday, November 1. This will minimize my exposure to the public and allow us the time to seek treatment in Houston, Texas. We need to keep John well, so that he can get to Houston and get truly healthy again!

Our amazing staff of wonderful human beings have been so very loving and supportive! All prayers and well wishes are welcomed. John has a webpage on [CaringBridge.org](https://www.CaringBridge.org) where you can follow his treatment progress while we are in Houston and moving forward. Please understand that we may receive your messages with glad hearts, but not be able to answer them personally or in a timely manner while we are concentrating on **John's wellness.**

I will miss being present with you and pray that you remain well in body and in spirit until my return. God is with us. Know that we will be worshiping with so many of you virtually through our online campus and will be praying for our church family at this time.



Some Financial Relief May Be One Application Away: Asbury Community Cares Fund

Friends, these are hard financial times for some in the Asbury community.

An 'Asbury Emergency Funding Task Force' was created to help ensure no Asburian lost their home due to the pandemic.

We were thinking of and praying for you while we worked!

Please do not let pride stop you from applying to see if there might be some financial assistance available to help you through these difficult times.

Time may be running out to apply for some of these grants!

If you need financial help with your rent, mortgage, utilities and other things, please don't let pride stand in your way when there might be help just one application away.

Asbury has partnered with the experts at the non-profit Family Promise to help both individuals and families try to find financial resources that best fit your situation:

If you live in the city of Savannah, or Chatham, Effingham or Bryan county, there may be help for you through some emergency state, county and/or city grants. Again, **time may be running out to apply for these grants! Do NOT delay in applying!**

There is also a fund called the Asbury Community Cares Fund, given by Asburians *just* to help people in the Asbury community. This fund may be able to help you!

With one application through Family Promise you can apply for emergency state, county and city grants, as well as the Asbury Community Cares Fund, which was donated by Asburians *just* to help people in the Asbury community.



