Jesus: A Pilgrimage by James Martin, SJ.

James Martin, SJ, gifted storyteller, editor at large of America magazine, popular media commentator, and New York Times bestselling author of *The Jesuit Guide to (Almost) Everything*, brings the Gospels to life in *Jesus: A Pilgrimage*, and invites believers and seekers alike to experience Jesus through Scripture, prayer and travel. Combining the fascinating insights of historical Jesus studies with profound spiritual insights about the Christ of faith, Father Martin recreates the world of first-century Galilee and Judea to usher you into Jesus's life and times and show readers how Jesus speaks to us today. Martin also brings together the most up-to-date Scripture scholarship, wise spiritual reflections, and lighthearted stories about traveling through the Holy Land with a fellow (and funny) Jesuit, visiting important sites in the life of Jesus of Nazareth.

Keeping a Princess Heart by Nicole Johnson.

Snow White, Cinderella, and Sleeping Beauty. Every little girl grew up hearing the stories of "happily ever after," but is that the world in which she exists today? Living in this not-so-fairy-tale world, you are torn between everything you longed for and everything you live with. You wonder how your heart will survive, because what you have isn't even close to what you hoped for. Hang on! Real hope is found in the tension between the two-in an invisible kingdom. This place is where you discover the true heart of a princess-one full of dreams, wonder, delight, and joy. And you learn to keep it alive, even in the midst of this crazy, disappointed, hard-to-understand world.

Springtime of the Soul by Carole Hamm.

Scared and alone, her husband lying near death, Carole Hamm quietly uttered four words that changed her life. As the crisis threatened to engulf her and her family, she decided to let God lead the way. "Thy will be done," she prayed giving God complete control for the first time in her life. Eventually the crisis passed, but the seeds of Carole's faith started to stir. This book is written from a collection of Carole's journal entries during that time period, uses the daffodil as a metaphor for her own blossoming faith. *Springtime of the Soul* also serves a guide for anyone struggling with their own faith or who longs for a deeper relationship with God.

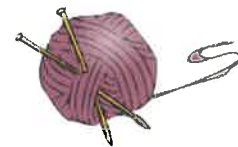


1ST SUNDAY FOOD PANTRY, SUNDAY MAY 6TH

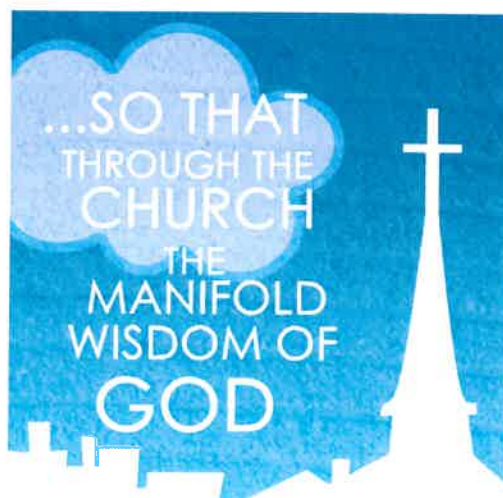
