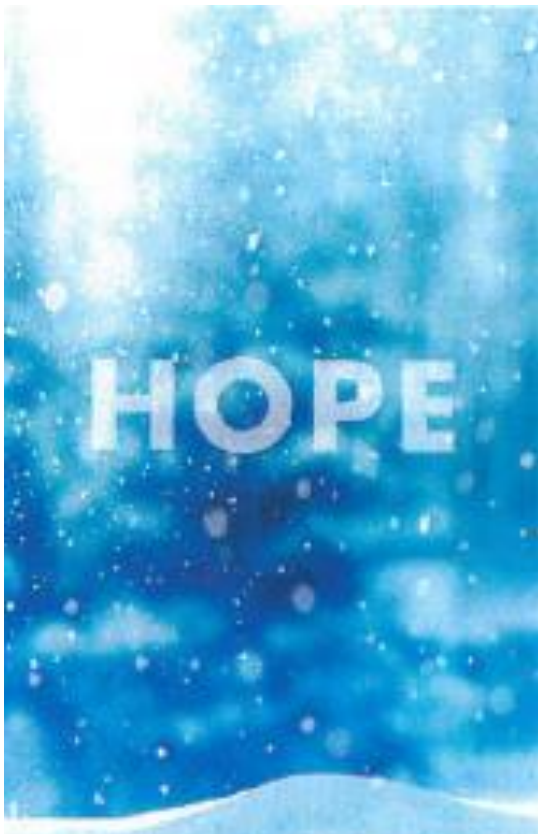
Service of Light in the Midst of Darkness:
