## MARCHing THROUGH LENT (pun intended)



I write "marching" because the Lenten season can fly by so quickly that we might miss the richness of the season. We continue to walk with Peter as he walks with Jesus on his final days here on earth. We will be privileged to be on the scene as Peter proclaims Jesus as Messiah, son of the living God. Then the next week, literally Peter's next breath, Peter rebukes Jesus after he told the disciples of his pending death and resurrection. The next week we hear Peter ask Jesus how many times he should forgive one who sins against him, with Jesus' shocking answer of seventy-seven times.

Then Holy Week arrives with the pageantry of Palm Sunday, where the great crowd shouts, "Hosanna," which confuses the disciples completely until after Jesus is glorified. On Maundy Thursday we are present at the Upper Room where Jesus, knowing that the hour had come for him to leave the world, performs his deepest work of servanthood in washing the disciples' feet. Good Friday finds us with Jesus in the garden as Judas betrays him, moving Peter to anger and cutting off the ear of Malchus, servant of the high priest. We also hear Peter's three denials of Christ and the sound of the rooster crowing.

Easter Sunday finds us running alongside Peter toward the tomb upon word that it was empty and Jesus wasn't there. Peter not knowing what happened, the mystery of Christ's resurrection continues into April (sneak peak!), and he sees Jesus on the shore building a fire. And yes, we have one more miraculous catch of fish—the ultimate full circle moment.

So much of God's love in so little time! Indeed, we're marching through Lent to the day of resurrection and beyond. Prepare to be overwhelmed by God's goodness, mercy, and love!

Beautiful sounding news is here!!!! More beautifully sounding music is coming soon!!!

The installation of the long awaited Trumpet En Chamade & Digital Antiphonal Division for our existing organ will begin the week of March 11th!

This antiphonal organ will complete the full vision of the new sanctuary and was included in the original designs and concepts. During construction, parts of the sanctuary were built to support this feature on the north wall. All of the support, hardware, and electrical is already installed just waiting to be used. This project has already been fully funded with specific designated donations for the organ over the last several years.

This will be a big draw for Ascension. Ascension will be one of two churches with a working antiphonal organ division. The other is at the St. Norbert Abbey. With this addition we plan to host more musical events and bring in outside musicians to give concerts.

Step one of the installation will be the week of March 11th. You will be able to experience the wide range of how the antiphonal organ will enhance our worship experience, when it fully surrounds the congregation after the completion of the installation in May.

Due to HIPAA privacy laws, the church is often not informed when a person is hospitalized. Please call the church office when you would like a pastoral visit when you are in the hospital. Do not rely on the hospital to call the church office, even if they have said they will. Please call the church office directly, or have a family member do so.
