### A Kairos Moment- Pastor Jack

Abiding Savior is at a "kairos" moment – a Biblical notion of a special time pregnant with opportunity but not with danger. The calling of a new pastor to be the spiritual leader of this congregation is very important. It needs the involvement of every member. Ask yourself two questions:

- What is my vision of my spiritual needs am I and my family living in the joy of Christ and being a blessing to them as we are blessed by God's grace? If not, what do I need from the church to help me?
- What is God's vision and will for this congregation in our community for today and tomorrow? Do we have the programs and ministries in operation that are needed for us as individuals and families and a faith community to be inspired to respond effectively to the call of Christ to us today and for the future?

Pray and talk about these questions around your family table and in other settings with other members.

It is said that 70% of the American population are passive-dependent. Rather than being responsible and participating and speaking and contributing to the effort in a timely way, they are irresponsible by being silent, not contributing, and after a decision is made, they complain and blame others for decisions they themselves made no effort to address. Some also feel the pandemic has reinforced that attitude in many people. Pity the congregation and lay leaders where that dynamic is in operation.

Let it not be so for you, for your family, or Abiding Savior. It's your life...your church...your future. Recognize the "kairos" moment of opportunity for change, for renewal, for catching a clever, bright and enduring glimpse of God's wonderful desire for you, for Abiding Savior, and for the world. Christ will change the glimpse into an enduring perspective for everyday living – as beautiful and new as the sunrise, and as rich with promise as the rainbow, the symbol of God's covenant with Noah and with us.

Now that we have extended a call to Pastor Paul Frerichs of Redeemer Lutheran Church in Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio, pray for him as he considers where God wants him to serve.

Continue to pray for your involvement as well, and how you will help our new Pastor when he comes. What do you see? What do Christ and this congregation have for you? What is your part in the ministry? What will become of you, of this congregation? It's up to you. Catch a glimpse and share your vision. The best is yet to come.

# The Great Sending - A Study During Lent

President Walton of our Florida-Georgia District has declared 2022 as The Great Sending Year of Jubilee. Each chapter of the book connects God's heart to your own through a deep dive into Scripture. Rev. Dr. Will Sohns, editor of The Great Sending, encourages us, "God's Sending is a call to join Him in something beyond self, beyond a congregation, and beyond a denomination. God is calling us to much more. His Great Sending is His heartbeat for the world that He wants beating in and through you."

All our members are invited to join together and study this book as part of our midweek services during Lent, beginning Wednesday, March 2nd. Each week we will focus on a main chapter theme, like Engaging Disciples in the Great Sending, and The Great Sending Essentials. The book also provides short daily devotions to use between services. These chapters will help guide us, maybe for the first time, out of the sanctuary into the streets, out of our comfort zones and into community, out of our affinity groups to meet people who are perishing without Jesus. It may lead to new conversations among our members. It's not just a book to read. It's a way to immerse yourself in God's Word. It's a way of connecting you and others to Jesus. Plan now to join this study each week, either live in church or by livestream.
