Come and See the Lord! - Pastor Glover

But Mary stood outside by the tomb weeping, and as she wept she stooped down and looked into the tomb. And she saw two angels in white sitting, one at the head and the other at the feet, where the body of Jesus had lain. Then they said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping?"

She said to them, "Because they have taken away my Lord, and I do not know where they have laid Him."

Now when she had said this, she turned around and saw Jesus standing there, and did not know that it was Jesus. Jesus said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you seeking?"

She, supposing Him to be the gardener, said to Him, "Sir, if You have carried Him away, tell me where You have laid Him, and I will take Him away."

Jesus said to her, "Mary!"

She turned and said to Him, "Rabboni!" (which is to say, Teacher).

Jesus said to her, "Do not cling to Me, for I have not yet ascended to My Father; but go to My brethren and say to them, 'I am ascending to My Father and your Father, and to My God and your God."

Mary Magdalene came and told the disciples that she had seen the Lord, and that He had spoken these things to her.

(John 20:11-18, NKJV)

Holy Week is upon us. Easter is upon us. The most important week – the most important day of the year is upon us.

And with this important time comes the always present opportunity for you to come and see our Lord. That's right, you get to see Jesus!

As you likely already know, we are going to have services at Abiding Savior for 8 days in a row during Holy Week. From Palm Sunday through Easter Sunday, there will be a service every day. On each of those days, you can come to our sanctuary to hear the Word of the Lord proclaimed. On Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Easter Vigil, and Easter Day, you can come to our sanctuary to feast on the Body and Blood of our Lord. We will sing hymns. We will pray. We will confess. And we will see the Lord.

You need not make it to every service during Holy Week, but I do hope you will take advantage of this opportunity to be in the presence of the Risen Lord.

Our hymnal, the Lutheran Service Book, reminds us that "Our Lord serves us through His holy Word and Sacraments. Through these means, He comes among us to deliver His forgiveness and salvation, freeing us from our sins and strengthening us for service to one another and to the world...The Lord's service calls forth our service – in sacrifices of praise and thanksgiving to Him and in loving service to one another" (viii).

So come and see. Come and see the Lord. For He is Risen! He is Risen indeed!
