Florida Georgia Lutheran Early Response, Inc. a need to be met

The Florida-Georgia Lutheran Early Response, Inc. (FGLER) was recently incorporated as a non-profit to assist the LCMS, its Districts and congregations in Florida, Georgia, and elsewhere to minister to and assist those affected by a disaster. Our first opportunity to help came last Fall responding to help with the Hurricane Ian cleanup in the Fort Myers, FL area.

Earlier this spring, devasting tornadoes struck the Little Rock, AR area. At the request of LCMS Disaster Response and the Mid-South



District, FGLER responded to help. During its time there, the Bobcat loader operated by FGLER experienced some mechanical problems. Upon return to Florida, it was taken to the dealer for repairs. In weighing options, the FGLER Board of Directors has determined that the best option would be to purchase a new Bobcat MT100 mini-track loader. Being a new organization, FGLER does not have funds on hand to make such a large purchase approximately \$43,000.
