How Can You Serve? - Pastor Glover

"As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace: whoever speaks, as one who speaks oracles of God; whoever serves, as one who serves by the strength that God supplies—in order that in everything God may be glorified through Jesus Christ. Dear friends in Christ,

As we prepare for Ash Wednesday (on Valentine's Day, February 14th, of all days!) and for the season of Lent, I would like you all to consider this question: How can you serve? We will of course, as we do every year during Lent, consider the spiritual disciplines of fasting, almsgiving, and prayer, as we seek to answer this question. But even more than these, I'd like us all to contemplate how we can serve the Lord and His church. Specifically, I'd like you to consider how you can serve the ministry of Abiding Savior Lutheran Church and School.

I pose this question not to suggest that you are currently not serving. Nor am I implying that you are not serving enough or that you need to serve better. So many of you faithfully and passionately serve the ministry of Abiding Savior every week and I am constantly amazed of how truly committed you are to this place and the work we do.

But as we do every year during Lent, it is good, right, and salutary for us to do [re]consider how we serve the One who daily serves us. It could be continuing the service you are already doing. Whatever it is though, I'd like to you to take some time and consider your service here. Do this not because God will love you more or because you will have more sins forgiven. Neither of these things are true. God loves you perfectly on account of your faith in Christ. Your sins are totally forgiven because of what this Christ did for you on the cross and in the empty tomb.

Whatever you can do, whatever you can give, however you can serve, let us know. Your church and school is ready to receive your time, talents, and treasures!
