

CPAL'S COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN

During this COVID-19 outbreak, CPAL is committed to doing all we can to create a safe environment for our staff and students. We have developed this plan according to guidance from local health authorities. This plan is subject to change:

- All staff, students, and visitors over 2-years-old will wear a mask.

- For drop off and pick up, families will wait outside on the walkway, 6 feet apart from other families. Children must hold hands with their parents and will not be allowed to run around the parking lot or climb on the guard rail while waiting.

- Children and staff will be screened for temperature and other symptoms at the door. Children or staff with temperatures 100.4 or higher, or with other symptoms, will be required to stay home.

- The Director will communicate with parents about how long a child with symptoms would need to stay home, according to local health guidance. Be prepared that this could be as little as 1 to 3 days, or as much as 14 days or more, depending on the circumstances.

- Families will inform the school if their child has a confirmed or suspected case of Covid-19, or is in close contact with someone with a confirmed case. The Director will follow local health guidance regarding: how long that child should stay home, whether others are notified, whether others need to stay home, and whether the school should be closed for a time. Parents are advised to prepare for these possibilities and have backup childcare available.

- All commonly-touched surfaces will be regularly cleaned and disinfected.

- Children will be guided to learn and play at a distance from each other as much as possible. We will keep our windows open, as weather permits, for ventilation. Our staff is encouraged to take the learning outside more often.

- We will provide separate supplies and toys for children as much as possible. Shared toys will be cleaned and disinfected frequently.

- Children will be guided to wash hands frequently, and will be guided in the use of hand sanitizer.

- This Safety Plan is subject to change. The school will inform you of any changes, as soon as possible.
