Rules for Prayer Chain Members: Prayer requests may come from any source, anyone in need of prayer. Prayer requests should be phoned to Pastor at 529-5471- office. Include only the information you want communicated.



Directions for Prayer Chain members when receiving a call:

Write down the prayer request. Pass on exact information about prayer requests during the call. Please call the person directly following your name. **If no answer, keep calling down the list until someone answers**, thus keeping the chain going. (You may back up later to inform those not answering, but this is not required.) Use mature Christian judgment on this. Immediately after making the call, pray concerning requests. Don't leave your phone until you have prayed, so you don't become involved in other things before your prayer. Pray God's will. (Don't pray answers, pray requests to God.) Pray fervently.



Ministry of Our Service Groups

We each have God-given talents and gifts. The Spirit invites us to share these gifts. You have been assigned to be a working partner in one of our church's four Service Groups. As events and projects arise in our church home, a caller from your particular Service Group will contact you, asking you and your spouse and children to share your time and talents. Sometimes you may be asked to furnish a cake for a funeral or help serve a fund-raising event, a funeral or a reception. Other times you may be called on to help clean church or to help with spring clean-up outdoors. We invite you to become an active member of your Service Group in order that the commitments taken on by the church family might be completed. Service Group Coordinators are the designated people who assume leadership of any event served from the church kitchen. They are encouraged to plan their event with their other group members. The Coordinators are responsible to order food and organize the team of workers.

2019 ELCA Women's and Family Service Group Policies

1. WELCA offerings shall be given to the Treasurer of WELCA monthly.
2. 25% of the WELCA Offerings will be sent to State Synod WELCA Treasurer annually.
3. Money received from funerals, weddings, and other sources may be designated to a special project.
4. Use of kitchen equipment: shall be checked out by the WELCA coordinating board. The list is inside the door of the broom closet. Cannot loan: silverware, dishes, silver cabinet items, newer tables, newer chairs or punch bowl.. Can use: older tables and chairs through the checkout person.
5. A yearbook shall be prepared by the coordinating board each year. Suggestions for improvement are welcome.
6. Church Council has determined that non-members are charged \$400.00 for the use of the church, social hall and kitchen. An additional \$100 will be charged if a service group is needed. If the facility is returned to the way it was a \$100 refund will be given. Members may use facility free of charge with donations welcome, but not required.
7. A quilt is given to those graduating from high school.
8. Bibles are given to those completing the 1st grade (given in September).
9. Prayer Pillows are given to the children enrolling in their first year of Sunday School.
10. Historian keeps up history books and pictorial.
11. A \$10 memorial will be sent to the family of any former pastor upon their death from the East Nidaros Women of the ELCA.
