STEWARDSHIP

June 9 – Pentecost

Acts 2:1 – **“When the day of Pentecost arrived, they were all together in one place.”** Notice that Pentecost is actually an Old Testament festival. It happens around the time when the wheat and oats are ready to be brought in. In the New Testament, this becomes a picture and foreshadowing of the great harvest of humankind that God means to bring in through the preaching of His Word. God gives the seed, and God brings about the harvest – through the work of His Church.

Assemble Fabric Kits for Lutheran World Relief (LWR) Wednesday, June 26 at 9 am in the Sunday School area. SPECIAL CONGREGATIONAL VOTERS' MEETING

A special Congregational Voters' meeting has been scheduled for Sunday, June 23, 2019 beginning approximately 10:15 AM to discuss and vote on the topic of Worship Service times. The Elders have determined the voters shall decide between these two Worship schedule options:

1. No change to Labor Day to Memorial Day (winter) worship service schedule: Second and fourth Thursday evenings Worship at 7:00 PM, Sunday morning Worship at 8:00 and 10:30 AM with Christian Education hour beginning at about 9:20 AM.
2. Change the full-year schedule to match summer worship schedule: Every Thursday evening Worship at 7:00 PM and one Sunday morning Worship at 9:00 AM, with Christian Education hour beginning at about 10:20 AM. Thursday evening Worship services would continue through Lent, with Lenten service on Wednesdays.
