In July, 1780, a man named Robert Raikes from England started the first "Sabbath School" to help poor working children learn morals, to read and write and to learn about their Savior. After three years, the idea of Sunday School caught on to more groups. By 1850, there were more than 2,000,000 students across England which branched from his Sunday School program! Once traditional schools got more common, Sunday School became a way to give children a Christian education and to prepare for a Christian life, spreading the Good News of our Savior. 4-Ingredient Cream Cheese Apple Dip

Yield: 16 servings (1/2 cup per serving)

- 1/2 cup cream cheese, softened
- 1/2 cup mayonnaise
- 1/2 cup sour cream
- 1/2 cup applesauce

Directions:

1. In a medium bowl, combine cream cheese, mayonnaise, sour cream, and applesauce.
2. Stir until well combined.
3. Serve with sliced apples for dipping.

Notes:

- 1. You can substitute in a fruit of your choice.
- 2. This dip is best served chilled.
