

Our Lenten Theme this year is "Calling Us Home..." and is based on 1 Peter in the New Testament.

"Here we have no lasting city, but we seek the city that is to come" (Hebrews 13:14). In Lent and Easter, we invite worshippers to the eternal truths that guide our pilgrimage toward eternity. The short First Epistle of Peter, only 105 verses, is rich with guidance and encouragement for living in a post-church and increasingly secular society. Five times Peter tells the scattered congregations of Asia Minor that they are called by God and it's those passages that serve as the starting point for the midweek Lenten services.

When we go on a journey, we can't take everything with us. So, during the Sundays in Lent, we'll talk about leaving something behind, some baggage that we don't need on our heavenward journey. This year we will join a journey that others have taken for centuries. We are God's "peculiar" people, and He continues to call us "strangers and sojourners" home to Himself.

I pray that you would join us on the journey this year and that you would be blessed along the way!

**P.S.** – Since I've been asked this, I (Pastor Mike) will be at Bethany leading and preaching all of the Lenten services (God-willing, of course!).


