


we caught were tagged and released. We had a lot of fun learning about the butterflies!

Luke 10 After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them on ahead of him, twoby two, into every town and place where he himself was about to go. 2 And he said to them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest. 3 Go your way; behold, I am sending you out as lambs in the midst of wolves.

There is a certain thrill of excitement and a corresponding sense of dread that comes along with this text isn't there? Christ sends out the disciples on their world changing mission, and then immediately adds that they will not being going out into the world unopposed. In fact, the opposite is true, they will be under constant fire, overwhelmed by enemies on every side, and they will do all of this without any defenses of their own other than the Lord's promises and someone beside them to remind them of those promises.

When Jesus sent out His disciples, He didn't send them alone, but rather in pairs. Furthermore, He didn't send them anywhere that He Himself was not going, (notice it says "where he himself was about to go.") God knows what we need and does His work through us in teams, groups, and congregations, just as lambs are not sent out alone but in flocks where they can close ranks.



#### National Children's Health Month

Children's Health Month reminds us of the importance of protecting our children's health from environmental hazards in places where they live, play, and learn. Children are vulnerable to exposure to environmental contaminants, such as lead. The United States Environmental Protection Agency created a list for ways to improve your child's health.

**Get Your Child Tested for Lead:** Have your child tested for lead at 12 & 24 months old by their health care provider or your local health department.

**Keep Our Air Breathable:** Instead of driving your children to school and after-school activities, have them walk, bike, or use public transportation.

Reduce Your Use of Plastic Bags and Bottles: Pack children's school lunches in reusable bags and give them a reusable bottle for water at lunch and during practices.

**Help Kids Eat Healthier Food:** Feed your kids more fruits and vegetables, less sugar, and fewer carbonated beverages and processed foods. Have regular family meals. Be a role model by eating healthy yourself.

**3e Sun Wise:** Help kids avoid sunburns with sun-protective clothing, hats and sunscreen, and by seeking shade when the sun's rays are strongest.

**lelp Children Avoid "Nature Deficit Disorder":** Cut back on screen time and help kids injoy the great outdoors.

**)on't Smoke Around Children:** Until you quit, choose to smoke outside. Do not smoke in our home or car and do not allow family and visitors to do so.



### **Bullying Prevention Month**

More than 1 out of every 5 students will be bullied this year.

Bullying directly affects a student's ability to learn. Students who are bullied often do not want to go to school, may find it difficult to concentrate, and lose self-esteem and self-confidence.
