
Distribution



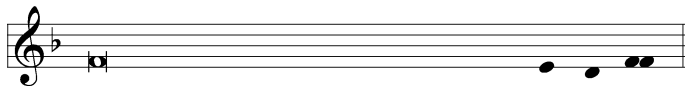
