Dear Members and Friends of Calvary Lutheran Church,

I begin this last newsletter article with words written by the Apostle Paul in his letter to the young church at Philippi.

Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ <sup>3</sup>I thank my God every time I remember you, <sup>4</sup>constantly praying with joy in every one of my prayers for all of you, <sup>5</sup>because of your sharing in the gospel from the first day until now. <sup>6</sup>I am confident of this, that the one who began a good work among you will bring it to completion by the day of Jesus Christ. (Philippians 1:2-6)

I began my service as your Interim Pastor fifteen months ago on August 1, 2022. Now my time as your pastor is quickly drawing to a close. I will be taking some vacation time on Reformation Sunday (October 29) and All Saints Sunday (November 5) as Anita and I attend a family wedding in Kansas and then travel to St. Louis, Missouri for a We Raise board meeting and a visit with our daughter and family. Upon our return my last Sundays leading worship will be November 12 and 19.

I believe the Holy Spirit has been at work in the Church over these past weeks and months. God has been at work in the leadership of the congregation; in the prayers, patience and understanding of congregational members; in the work of the Call Committee as well as in the heart and soul of pastors in the larger church discerning what possibilities God might be creating and where God might be calling. I rejoice with Calvary Lutheran Church and with Pastor Ben Williams whom the congregation has called to serve as your next pastor. Pastor Williams is a wonderfully gifted younger pastor who is well suited to lead this congregation into the next chapter of your life and ministry.

The leaders of Calvary have done some excellent work over these past months in preparing to live into the next chapter of the congregation's life. A year ago this November facilitator Cathy Cowling (<a href="https://churchwerkes.com/">https://churchwerkes.com/</a>) led the congregation in a Sunday meeting called "Looking Back, Moving Forward." I remember we had hoped for 75 people and were thrilled that closer to 135 people participated in that event. Following the Annual Meeting this past February Cathy also led a joint staff and Church Council retreat in which leaders began imagining and laying the groundwork for the future.

A Constitution Committee was appointed to revise Calvary's constitution based upon the ELCA Model Constitution. A Church Structure Committee also began work and is in the process of presenting its recommendations to the Church Council. And, finally, the Call Committee was formed and diligently and prayerfully served the congregation by identifying and presenting Pastor Ben Williams as the recommended candidate to be called. For all this we give thanks to God and pray God's blessing upon the continued work of the congregation.

In July Calvary gave thanks for the ministry of Pastor Rufus Kudee and prayed God's rich blessings upon him and his family as he accepted a call to a congregation in the Lacrosse Area Synod. Now the time is nearing for my service among you to come to an end. It has been a joy and a privilege to have served as your pastor during this time. My wife Anita has been with me most every Sunday (yes, sitting through both services and listening to my sermons), and I have been very grateful for her support and understanding. We have gotten to know and love the people of Calvary. We will miss you but the time has come for us to say goodbye and move on to the next chapter of our lives.

As Paul wrote to the Philippians so I will thank God every time I think of you, with a heart filled with joy. We have shared in the Gospel of Jesus Christ from the very first day and the Spirit of the Risen Christ has been at work among you. We trust the Holy Spirit will bring that work to completion in the day of Jesus Christ.

I close with these words from Paul to the Romans: The God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.







If so, the Calvary Endowment Trust Committee is accepting scholarship applications for the 2023 second semester.


