New Year, New Us

"So, if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation: everything old has passed away; see, everything has become new! All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation; that is, in Christ, God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting the message of reconciliation to us." 2 Corinthians 5:17-19

It is once again the beginning of a new year, a time of resolutions and goal setting, of new beginnings and new habits. I have a fondness for the beginning of a new year. It's full of potential yet to be discovered. On January 1st, the whole year sprawls out ahead of us like an open highway. It is common to be setting New Year's Resolutions right about now. In my own experience, resolutions tend to be set in vain. I have good intentions, but ultimately lack the motivation or will to truly make a lasting impact.

This time of year, I am reminded about the futility of setting these sorts of resolutions. But I am also reminded of the hope that these resolutions give us. It was said to me best one Sunday afternoon at camp. I was leading the opening session of a week-long high school summer bible camp. I knew some of the campers from years prior; so, I knew how hard it might be to get them to focus! But, when I went to start the session, they immediately turned to face me, and sat down. I couldn't believe it! I told them I was impressed and that they must have matured over the last year. One camper, a junior in high school, raised his hand and said, "What can we say? New year. New us!"

That's the hope, we Christians, find at this time of year. We are in the middle of the story of Jesus being born, living life among us, and making his way to Jerusalem – where he will be sentenced, put to death on a cross, and ultimately, rise from the grave Easter morning. And in that story, everything old passes away – everything becomes new! As Paul writes, "...God was reconciling the world to himself..." This new year is an opportunity for us to be transformed by God's love in Christ Jesus; to become the new us that the Holy Spirit is calling forth from the tomb. And this is God's work of reconciling the world to himself. God does not count our past failings to love God and love our neighbor against us. Rather, God gives us a new identity as children of God with a new purpose unfolding before us.

God entrusts to us the message of reconciliation; of restoring right relationship with God and with one another. And that is our new beginning this year, Dear Ones. The last several years have wreaked havoc on communities throughout the world; and you too have certainly felt that tension here. You have been learning to hold space as you let go of what has passed while looking forward to God's preferred and promised future. And now, the Holy Spirit is calling us to something new, a new identity and purpose for God's ministry here at Calvary.

As you well know, living, learning, and loving in community – yes, even Christ's community – is difficult. And it becomes easier when we look to God and the unfolding story the Holy Spirit is unraveling before us. It becomes easier when we see that God is actively bringing new life and energy into our community. It becomes easier when we let God do what God does best: love people through our brokenness. So, this new year, let us ground ourselves in God's story of love; let us join God's work of restoration; and let us proclaim, "New Year! New Us!"
