### **Letter from the Pastor**

### **Through Every Door**

As August unfolds, we find ourselves standing in that holy threshold between endings and beginnings. The warmth of summer still lingers, yet there's a familiar shift in the air: store shelves fill with school supplies, calendars crowd with upcoming commitments, and we sense that the door to a new season is slowly swinging open.

This month, we bring to a close our *Summer of Psalms*, a worship series that invited us to dwell in the raw, honest poetry of Scripture. Through psalms of praise, lament, trust, and thanksgiving, we were reminded that our full, complicated lives are welcome in God's presence. Thank you to everyone who shared a favorite psalm or a personal story—your voices helped deepen our collective song of faith.

Now, we find ourselves with one foot still in summer and the other stepping through the doorway into fall.

As we cross that threshold, we prepare to return to the *Narrative Lectionary*, the grand sweep of Scripture that starts in Genesis and carries us through the story of God's people—and our place in it. We'll walk with Abraham and Sarah, wrestle with prophets, and hear anew the promises of Jesus. It's a story that reminds us: God is with us in every season, guiding our steps through every door we cross.

So, whether you're starting a new grade, returning from time away, or simply sensing the turn of the season in your spirit, may this be a time of renewed purpose and holy expectation. And as we walk forward together, may we trust that God is already on the other side of every threshold, ready to meet us with grace.

I will leave you with this blessing from Meta Herrick Carlson:

Before you pass though stop long enough to hear your hopes for the other side.

You cannot know for sure just yet, which paints this portico in adventure. It's the unknowable that makes it wild.

## Church Council & Calvary Staff Spotlight


We're shining a spotlight on our Church Council and Calvary staff - learn more about their connection to the church and a few fun facts!

### Baptism Sundays




