Please note the following as worship services resume at Christ Lutheran inside the church building beginning July 12, 2020.

- Sunday services will continue to be broadcast over the FM transmitter for those who would like to attend worship but feel more comfortable remaining in their vehicles in the parking lot and listen to the service on the radio.
- Worshipers are welcome to wear masks if they desire but masks will not be required.
- **Parties** are defined as members of your extended family, individuals you see on a regular basis who are not members of your family, or individuals you are comfortable being seated with in the same row. *Parties* are asked to continue social distancing from other *parties*.
- A one-row gap must be maintained between *parties*. Every other pew has been roped off to help maintain proper social distancing.
- The Elders/Ushers will not be “policing” who sits in a particular row. You may sit in any row that is not roped off as long as you are comfortable with other individuals sitting in your row.
- Offerings will be collected either as you enter the parking lot or in a basket by each door upon arrival.
- Communion will be offered for both those worshipping inside as well as those who remain in their vehicles in the parking lot. Details are being refined as to how this will be conducted.

It is our intent to create a healthy environment for all attending our services. Please use good judgment on maintaining social distancing before and after each service. If you have business to conduct or would like to join in fellowship with other parties after worship, we ask that you please wait for the parking lot to clear out or gather in an area apart from other vehicles.
