PSALM 132:8-18 (antiphon: vs. 13)

- [P]** For the LORD has chosen Zion;
he has desired it for his dwelling place.
- [P]** Arise, O LORD, and go to your resting place,
you and the ark of your might.
- [C]** Let your priests be clothed with righteousness,
and let your saints shout for joy.
- [P]** For the sake of your servant David,
do not turn away the face of your anointed one.
- [C]** The LORD swore to David a sure oath from which he will not
turn back:
“One of the sons of your body I will set on your throne.
- [P]** If your sons keep my covenant and my testimonies that I shall
teach them,

- [P]** His enemies I will clothe with shame,
but on him his crown will shine.”
- [C]** Glory be to the Father and to the Son
and to the Holy Spirit;
as it was in the beginning,
is now, and will be forever. Amen.
