¹ The Lord appeared to [Abraham] by the oaks of Mamre, as he sat at the door of his tent in the heat of the day. ²He lifted up his eyes and looked, and behold, three men were standing in front of him. When he saw them, he ran from the tent door to meet them and bowed himself to the earth ³and said, "O Lord, if I have found favor in your sight, do not pass by your servant. ⁴Let a little water be brought, and wash your feet, and rest yourselves under the tree, ⁵while I bring a morsel of bread, that you may refresh yourselves, and after that you may pass on—since you have come to your servant." So they said, "Do as you have said." ⁶And Abraham went quickly into the tent to Sarah and said, "Quick! Three seahs of fine flour! A short Voters' Meeting will be held immediately after the announcements to address increased insurance premiums for the church. Please sign in and stay a few extra minutes so that the voters can quickly take care of this matter. Thanks, Mark Bonewell, CLC Congregation President.

Background:

During 2024, the church insurance premiums were \$1,073.91 per month. The 2025 budget was set at \$13,000 for the insurance premiums. In January 2025, the premiums were increased about 62% to \$1,738.91 per month. As of the end of July, the budgeted amount for the church insurance has been exhausted. Thus, the voters are being asked to increase the 2025 budget by \$8,700 to cover the church insurance premiums for August thru December.

Motion:

To amend the Church 2025 Budget line item 6610 to \$21,700 to cover the increased insurance premiums.
