A Brief History

In January of 1965 two WELS churches, Mt. Olive and Pilgrim, merged and formed Christ Our Redeemer. In March of 1967 a new church building on Alameda and Locust Street was dedicated and in the fall a newly built parsonage next door. In 1968, a call was extended

to Miss Vanita Schrupp of St. Louis Park, MN, which was accepted. She arrived in July and along with Pastor Victor Bittorf, visited members and lined up the first class. Pastor Bittrof, who had been ill, was hospitalized the later part of July 1968 and the Lord called him home on August 31, 1968. Pastor Bittorf had worked with great diligence in helping build COR Church and School.

In September 1968 our school opened with nine children & Miss Schrupp in attendance.

"Excellent resources—best I've seen." That praise came from a WELS foster parent who has taken abuse prevention training twice before seeing "Standing Up for Children: A Christian Response to Child Abuse and Neglect." All WELS churches and schools need to be safe places where leaders actively work to prevent abuse. WELS Freedom for the Captives (FFTC) offers online training videos taught by experts Mr. Victor Vieth, the national director emeritus of Gundersen National Child Protection Training Center, and Prof. John Schuetzer, WELS seminary professor and counselor. The training consists of four videos with quizzes for each of the videos. Those who watch the videos and pass the quizzes will receive a certificate to show they have completed training. For a few larger conferences, Mr. Vieth is willing to do the training.

Board of Finance Update

At the end of the first quarter of the year, our income is running about \$4,500 behind the budgeted amount. In addition, our expenses are running approximately \$1,070 below what we anticipated in our budget.

Our 2018 Budget uses \$23,385 of our Contingency Fund to balance it. We would need to increase our offerings by 7.5% to not depend on the Contingency Fund.
