Confession of Sins

M: In the name of our God, to Whom all hearts are open and from Whom no secrets are hidden.

ALL: I confess that I am by nature sinful

PSALM 22

- M: My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?
- C: Why are You so far from helping Me, And from the words of My groaning?
- M: O My God, I cry in the daytime, but You do not hear;
- C: And in the night season, and am not silent.
- M: But You *are* holy, Enthroned in the praises of Israel. Our fathers trusted in You;
- C: They trusted, and You delivered them. They cried to You, and were delivered; They trusted in You, and were not ashamed.
- M: But I *am* a worm, and no man; A reproach of men, and despised by the people.
- C: All those who see Me ridicule Me; They shoot out the lip, they shake the head, *saying*,
 - "He trusted in the LORD, let Him rescue Him; Let Him deliver Him, since He delights in Him!"
- M: But You are He who took Me out of the womb;
- C: You made Me trust while on My mother's breasts.
- M: I was cast upon You from birth. From My mother's womb You *have been* My God.
- C: Be not far from Me, For trouble is near; For there is none to help.
- M: Many bulls have surrounded Me; Strong *bulls* of Bashan have encircled Me.
 - C: They gape at Me *with* their mouths, *Like* a raging and roaring lion.
- M: I am poured out like water, And all My bones are out of joint;
- C: My heart is like wax; It has melted within Me.
- M: My strength is dried up like a potsherd,
- C: And My tongue clings to My jaws; You have brought Me to the dust of death.
- M: For dogs have surrounded Me;
- C: The congregation of the wicked has enclosed Me.
- M: They pierced My hands and My feet; I can count all My bones.
- C: They look *and* stare at Me. They divide My garments among them, and for My clothing they cast lots.
- M: But You, O LORD, do not be far from Me; O My Strength, hasten to help Me!
- C: Deliver Me from the sword, My precious *life* from the power of the dog.

- M: Save Me from the lion's mouth
- C: And from the horns of the wild oxen!
- M: You have answered Me. I will declare Your name to My brethren; In the midst of the assembly I will praise You.
- C: You who fear the LORD, praise Him! All you descendants of Jacob, glorify Him, And fear Him, all you offspring of Israel!
- M: For He has not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted;
- C: Nor has He hidden His face from Him; But when He cried to Him, He heard.
- M: My praise *shall be* of You in the great assembly; I will pay My vows before those who fear Him.
- C: The poor shall eat and be satisfied; Those who seek Him will praise the LORD. Let your heart live forever!
- M: All the ends of the world Shall remember and turn to the LORD,
- C: And all the families of the nations Shall worship before You. For the kingdom *is* the LORD's,
 - And He rules over the nations.
- M: All the prosperous of the earth Shall eat and worship;
 - C: All those who go down to the dust Shall bow before Him, Even he who cannot keep himself alive.
- M: A posterity shall serve Him. It will be recounted of the Lord to the *next* generation,
 - C: They will come and declare His righteousness to a people who will be born, That He has done *this*.
