M: In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.





FIRST LESSON: ACTS 3:11-20

¹¹ And as the lame man which was healed held Peter and John, all the people ran together unto them in the porch that is called Solomon's, greatly wondering.

¹² And when Peter saw it, he answered unto the people, Ye men of Israel, why marvel ye at this? or why look ye so earnestly on us, as though by our own power or holiness we had made this man to walk?

¹³ The God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the God of our fathers, hath glorified his Son Jesus; whom ye delivered up, and denied him in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let him go.

¹⁴ But ye denied the Holy One and the Just, and desired a murderer to be granted unto you;

¹⁵ And killed the Prince of life, whom God hath raised from the dead; whereof we are witnesses.

¹⁶ And his name through faith in his name hath made this man strong, whom ye see and know: yea, the faith which is by him hath given him this perfect soundness in the presence of you all.

¹⁷ And now, brethren, I wot that through ignorance ye did it, as did also your rulers.

¹⁸ But those things, which God before had shewed by the mouth of all his prophets, that Christ would suffer, he hath so fulfilled. ¹⁹ Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord.

²⁰ And he shall send Jesus Christ, which before was preached unto you.

SECOND LESSON: 1 JOHN 1:5 - 2:2

- ⁵ This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.
 - ⁶ If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth:
- ⁷But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.
 - ⁸ If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.
- ⁹ If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
 - ¹⁰ If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.
- **2** My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:

GOSPEL LESSON: LUKE 24:36-49



- ³⁶ And as they thus spake, Jesus himself stood in the midst of them, and saith unto them, Peace be unto you.
 - ³⁷But they were terrified and affrighted, and supposed that they had seen a spirit.
 - 38 And he said unto them, why are ye troubled? and why do thoughts arise in your hearts?
- ³⁹Behold my hands and my feet, that it is I myself: handle me, and see; for a spirit hath not flesh and bones, as ye see me have.
 - ⁴⁰ And when he had thus spoken, he shewed them his hands and his feet.
- ⁴¹ And while they yet believed not for joy, and wondered, he said unto them, Have ye here any meat?
 - ⁴² And they gave him a piece of a broiled fish, and of a honeycomb.


