

A Message From Pastor Bushre

Well, here we are at the beginning of August. Whether we want to admit it or not, summer is beginning to wind down. Our new Preschool year here at CtL begins the last week of August. We're heading into a new school year! This is a time of separation for parents and children as the kids leave summer vacation behind and head back to the classroom (though some parents might not be too upset about that). I was thinking about that, and separation in general, and it reminded me of those times back before Julie and I were married. During my first year of seminary, we had to do a long distance relationship. That year, she was in her senior year back in Michigan at Concordia, Ann Arbor, while I was in St. Louis. It was a long, hard year, with 500 miles separating the two of us. We talked on the phone a lot and took comfort in the fact that this separation would only last a year and then we'd be together. One of the Bible verses that comforted us during this time was Genesis 31:49b. That verse says, "May the Lord keep watch between you and me when we are away from each other" (NIV). It was the Lord's promise to keep watch over the other person that helped us make it through those tough times. It's very comforting to me to know that the Lord is in control of everything, watching over both my life, and the lives of all my loved ones.

A verse that reminds me that God is in complete control of everything, is James 4:13-15: "Now listen, you who say, 'Today or tomorrow we will go to this or that city, spend a year there, carry on business and make money.' Why, you do not even know what will happen tomorrow. Instead, you ought to say, "If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that."" Our lives are not our own. It's not in our power to direct our own lives. If it were, we sinners would mess everything up and no one would have a decent life. It's God who directs everything. He provides what we need and steers us along the path that He has for us in this life. It's comforting to me to know that I don't have to worry about tomorrow. God is in control, and that is a great thing because He's shown us that He loves us and takes care of us. He's
