The vision of enhancing our building to help us better live out our mission “to make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world,” will soon take shape before us. It's an exciting time! It's also a good time to remind ourselves that during the building project things will look and feel messy, be inconvenient, and definitely be different.

This week the church offices are being packed up and moved to the church's house on 3<sup>rd</sup> street (602 S. 3<sup>rd</sup> Street). Beginning next week, you will need to go there for any “in-person” church office needs.

This Sunday, March 8, will be the last day we occupy the part of our building involved in phase 1 of the project (Green Room south, including the gym). We'll celebrate the beginning of the project with a light meal after the 10:30 service (if you haven't already, please let the church office know you're eating lunch with us). After lunch we'll begin moving things out of the south part of our building to make way for the construction work. Thanks in advance for all your help on Sunday afternoon and next week with this move!

Beginning Sunday, March 15, you'll only be able to enter the building through the northwest, tower, or northeast entrances. In addition, our Sunday morning fellowship time will need to work differently. You'll pick up refreshments from the counter just outside the sanctuary and then move to the gathering space of your choice (Sunday School classroom or other space).

To free up gathering space around the sanctuary, most of the library shelving will be moved out. We'll also move tables to the very back part of the sanctuary (old cry room area). You'll be able sit around the tables in that area for the fellowship time and worship services if you choose to do so.

I know that's a lot of changes. In addition, I ask that you please be patient as we work through these transitions in the next few weeks.

This Sunday morning, we'll worship God, celebrate Holy Communion, and continue our “Echoes from the Cross” sermon series. Jesus has already asked God to forgive those who've crucified him ([www.mykdkd.com/united-methodist-church/](http://www.mykdkd.com/united-methodist-church/), March 1 service and sermon). What he does next is both great news and a big challenge! See you Sunday morning at 8:15 or 10:30!

Exciting times ahead! In preparation of the beginning of our renovation project we will be

disassembling and moving all of the spaces on the first floor from the Green Room steps south. This Sunday, **March 8 will be our last Sunday** to fellowship in the gym or use the east and west doors as an entrance to the building until we are complete with the renovation later this year.

**At noon on March 8, a light lunch will be provided** in the gym then we'll roll up our sleeves and start packing up and relocating items to the gym for storage during the renovation. We can use hands, boxes and packing materials as we'll be emptying all cupboards and drawers, taking down artwork as well as moving all the furniture.

During construction our office staff will temporarily relocate to the rental house we own at 602 S 3<sup>rd</sup> street - right behind the playground out our back door!

It'll all move pretty fast after that - we'll give weekly updates and post photos of the transformation. Thanks to all who have worked hard to bring this evolution of our ministry to life!
