Wrapping up our Simplify sermon series last Sunday, it struck me how these standards for Christian living of our Wesleyan heritage in the Methodist church are so appropriate right now. As we continue to navigate the uncertainties and complexities of the COVID-19 pandemic, these three simple rules based on Jesus teaching to love God and others well are Clinton UMC's guiding principles.

Currently we're continuing to offer "in-person" worship on Sunday mornings (8:15 and 10:30) with the same restrictions we've had since re-opening in June. We're also continuing to provide the 8:15 a.m. service live online and on the radio.

We've begun allowing our adult Sunday School classes to meet in the church building if they desire to do so. Starting in September we will begin to allow church committees to meet in the church building if the committee's leader desires to do so. Any classes or committees that meet in the church building will be required to follow appropriate practices (wear face masks, practice proper social distancing and hygiene, etc.).

Please keep our church and community in prayer as we continue to navigate this unprecedented time of living in with a pandemic. And please continue to pray for the many people who've been impacted in negative ways by COVID-19.

This week, my wife Natalie and I are taking a few days of vacation. Kelli Jenkins, one of our church's lay ministers, will be helping lead in worship and preaching this Sunday. Pray for Kelli as you gather for worship in-person, online, or on the radio.
