

I've lost count how many times we've removed a layer of dust only to replace it with a fresh coat the next day. The good news is there are not many rounds left to go as we have all the sheetrock hung as of today and the last

messes will be mudding, sanding and painting.

If you were at church last week, you got to see clear from our east wall to the west wall across the Upper Gathering space and have a glimpse of the expanse of additional space that will soon be available to support our fellowship before and after services. The carpet on the stairs up from the Lower Gathering space will soon be laid to quiet the little footsteps heading back up for another round on the slide and our grand table will find a home in the area the library used to occupy.

We'll be adding another pair of the unique leaded glass windows to the back wall of the Chapel to give visitors a glimpse of that beautiful and often overlooked space. Our heating and cooling systems have been updated along with the lighting and electrical systems and we'll have video streams available throughout the building to share upcoming events and announcements.

The north stairwell will be completely welded by this weekend and will soon provide easy access between all three floors.

The original Fellowship Hall in the basement is frequently used for classes, small dinners and group meetings. As part of our renovations it will receive new walls and paint, new ceiling and lighting, an additional sound barrier door to the elevator equipment and an improved air distribution plenum for the heating and cooling system. Not long from now and our friends from Westport Construction will make their final appearance and that last sweep up will be a celebration to remember!
