


Better yet drop off a small bag to your home bound neighbors to help them breeze through the heat wave!

Time for a Tune Up!

These may not look like organ pipes but these are the some of the tubes that make those beautiful sounds on Sunday morning! We've been getting a little tune up this summer from Quimby Organs in Warrensburg who did our last rebuild years ago. There are dozens of different shapes and sizes of tubes, pipes and boxes that create the variety of sounds our organ makes. The beautiful and shiny pipes that adorn the front of the sanctuary are only a few of the ranks that make up the organ—most of the sound actually comes from inside the chamber to the east of the chancel behind the grille in the brick wall.

Repairs this time are mostly replacing leather gaskets that keep the air in the chambers. Over time, they dry out and shrink making the instrument difficult to keep in tune. Sam ordered this work last fall but scheduling pushed us back to mid-summer.
