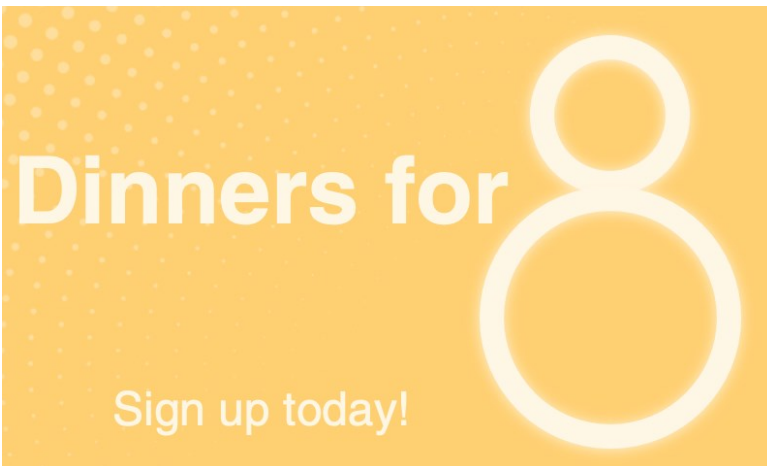


Tower Views—Clinton UMC

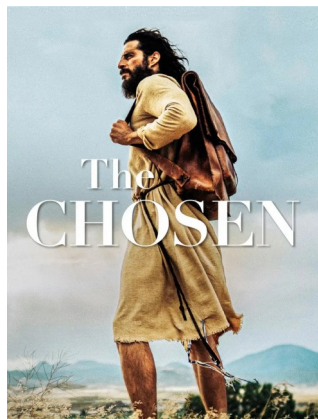
