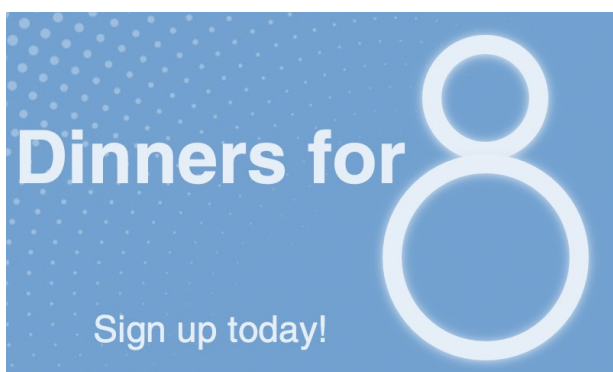




## CHS Testing Continues!
