

Frequently Asked Questions

What are the Objectives of the Capital Campaign?

There are three:

- 1) Mission Outreach: 10% of gifts received
- 2) Love of God's Creation Outdoor Spaces: Estimated to be \$150,000
- 3) Complete the building project by reducing, and ultimately eliminating, remaining mortgage debt of \$2.35 million

How will our tithes for Mission Outreach be used?

ECLC always begins by sharing the first 10% of gifts received. A tithe team has been formed to explore possibilities and make recommendations to the council. We will keep everyone informed as these exciting opportunities are chosen.

What are the plans for the Outdoor Space?

Our congregation sits on the banks of Minnehaha Creek. This land deserves our best efforts in caring for God's creation. An outdoor space task force has been formed and will be providing information as plans are developed. This process is similar to when our new sanctuary was built – we began the first campaign with a concept, and then specific plans followed.

We begin with these concepts:

- First, we honor the land and fulfill our obligation as stewards of this corner of creation by restoring ECLC's woods with native plants and trees.
- Secondly, we honor the saints who have gone before us by creating sacred outdoor space to reflect, remember and celebrate.
- Thirdly, we honor our future by creating usable outdoor space. We have an opportunity to vision how our remarkable facility can be enhanced with finishing touches to serve us and our neighborhood well into the future, and how our congregation can honor the land *and* enrich our congregation.

What are the Financials Goals for the Campaign?

- 10% of gifts received be designated for outreach
- \$150,000 is the estimated cost for outdoor spaces
- The more that is given, the more the debt will be reduced, as presented in this 3-tier goal:

Foundational goal: \$1.6 M.

(\$160,000 Mission Tithe, \$150,000 Outdoor Space, \$1.29 M debt reduction)

This was what was raised in the previous campaign. *Reaching this goal would reduce interest payments by over \$500,000.*

Mid-tier goal: \$2M (\$400,000 additional)

(\$200,000 Mission Tithe, \$150,000 Outdoor Space, \$1.6M debt reduction)

This would reduce the mortgage debt by 2/3 and provide even more funding that can be directed for mission and ministry instead of large mortgage payments. *Reaching this goal would reduce interest payments by nearly \$700,000.*

Aspirational goal: \$2.75M

(\$275K Mission Tithe, \$150,000 outdoor space; \$2.35M mortgage eliminated!)

The impact would be transformational for the future of ECLC. *Over \$1 million in future interest*payments would be saved and could be used for ECLC's mission and ministry instead of debt servicing!

How could we reach our aspirational goal?
