Devotion – All	Devotion (10 min.) – Small group reflections on Deep Roots  From eNews on June 29:  Saint Paul wrote, "Continue to live your lives in Christ, rooted and built up, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness."  As we prepare for what we anticipate will be our first somewhat "normal" fall, we are aware that for many, the past couple of years have been lean times. We have felt untethered from community. Like roots, so much of what has helped us in these times has been unseen, and sometimes unnamed.  Our theme, Deep Roots, will invite us to explore together where we are getting our strength, where we are finding our sustenance, and from where we might draw up hope to bear witness.  Discussion questions:  How might your particular role or ministry area directly or indirectly reflect this theme this fall?  What other ideas do you have for fall as you sit with this theme and language?				

Ministry update – 15 min	<ul> <li>Welcoming Ministry - Meredith Olson</li> <li>Welcoming events were slowed down considerably during the pandemic as we couldn't have in person welcoming.</li> <li>Now we're ready to move forward, and here's what we're doing: <ul> <li>Setting goals about how to build up the welcoming team and planning a kick off this Fall.</li> <li>Talking about what we want to bring back from past years, and what we want to change.</li> <li>Talking about how we can incorporate those who are attending church online?</li> <li>Planning an ice cream social with the shepherding group at the end of summer. This will be a way to welcome new members, welcome the LHCCC team, etc.</li> <li>Hoping to introduce some large in person gatherings this Fall – first thinking of new members for this, but definitely moving outward</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Capital campaign and finances - Kienan	<ul> <li>Finances – last week's letter was very helpful. A few households contacted Kienan and moved from monthly payments to one lump sum contribution this summer. That will help tremendously with cash flow.</li> <li>Current commitment numbers and pledge amounts (Kienan)- we have 106 pledges and \$977,000 so far. Remember that this is a 3 year campaign and we hope to meet our goal over these next 3 years.</li> </ul>
