FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK: Happy Reformation Day! Sola Gratia, Sola Fide, Sola Scriptura. These are the three key ideas of the Reformation. Through his studies and his life, God led Martin Luther to come to realizations of these key ideas that led the reformation of the Catholic Church of his time. God revealed the gospel message to Martin Luther through that salvation does not come by our good works. Salvation comes by **Grace Alone** through **Faith Alone** revealed in **Scripture Alone.** The three "Sola's" point to Solas Christus....**Christ Alone**. We can do nothing to earn our salvation but thanks be to God that he sent Christ to live a perfect life, take on the punishment for all of our sins, and conquer death to give us eternal life. God gives us the gift of faith by His Grace and uses scripture to reveal it all to us. What wonderful gifts God continues to give us! God will continue to use His people to grow and preserve His kingdom, just as he used Martin Luther 501 years ago. Have an enjoyable, relaxing, long weekend.

FROM PASTOR SKOVGAARD: What's the point of going to church for worship? With all the competing demands on our time, sometimes it's easy to forget why the Body of Christ, Christians, needs to gather for worship in the first place. We get worn down by the frenetic pace of life and even begin assuming that God would want us to sleep in and stay home on Sunday mornings. Consider these opening words of the Introduction in our previous hymnal, Lutheran Worship, as words worth pondering: "Our Lord speaks and we listen. His Word bestows what it says. Faith that is born from what is heard acknowledges the gifts received with eager thankfulness and praise.....Saying back to him what he has said to us, we repeat what is most true and sure. Most true and sure is his name, which he put upon us with the water of our Baptism. We are his. This we acknowledge at the beginning of the Divine Service. Where his name is, there he is....The rhythm of our worship is from him to us, and then from us back to him. He gives his gifts, and together we receive and extol them. We build one another up as we speak to one another in psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs. Our Lord gives us his body to eat and his blood to drink. Finally his blessing moves us out into our calling, where his gifts have their fruition."
