But, because of our good and gracious God, we confess with great confidence and assurance in the promises given by God of the forgiveness of sins, Eternal Life, and Salvation. When we defend our faith and speak for those who cannot speak for themselves, we are acknowledging Christ, and therefore acknowledging the Father. May God's word continue to work in your heart.

2019-2020 REGISTRATION IS NOW OPEN Registration is open on Fast Direct. Please log into your family account to register for next school year. It is a simple one click per child. Please also be mindful of the annual non refundable registration fee (per student) for next school year. They are as follows:

- Between April 13, 2019 and May 31, 2019 - \$150.00 per student
- After June 1, 2019 - \$250.00 per student
- Anytime for new families - \$75.00 per student

We request registration fees be paid to EGL by check unless you request to have your registration fee billed to you via TADS. If you would like you to be billed through TADS please email your request to Amy Stroh.

If you are a family that is participating in the Private School Choice Program these above amounts do not apply to you. However, we do ask that you please re-register in Fast Direct for next school year as well as through the Private School Choice Application at <https://apps4.dpi.wi.gov/ChoiceParent/> and provide EGL with the required verification documents.
