FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK: "When Esther's words were reported to Mordecai, he sent back this answer, 'Do not think that because you are in the king's house you alone of all the Jews will escape. For if you remain silent at this time, relief and deliverance for the Jews will arise from another place, but you and your father's family will perish. And who knows but that you have come to you royal position for such a time as this?'" Esther 4:12-14

During Chapel this week Pastor Skovgaard spoke to us about the story of Esther. Esther was in a very precarious position. Her people were being persecuted. Her uncle asked her to go before the king and explain the persecution and ask it to stop. Even though she was queen, she could not go before the king unless he requested her presence. If she did, the king would be within his rights to put her to death. What she needed to ask the King was a very risky question. Her uncle reminded her that God placed her in this position for a reason....for such a time as this.

This was the last chapel for our 8th grade students. As they move on to high school, some of them may not go to another chapel again. I reminded them that God will put them in the place he has called them to throughout their lives and God calls Christians to be bold, not timid. In order to keep that boldness, we need the strength God provides through His Word and Sacrament. I spoke to the 8th grade especially after chapel, but this goes to all of us. We NEED to be in worship. We NEED to receive communion. God asks us to be strong and courageous and does not give the Christian easy purposes. But, He gives His people all of the strength we need to accomplish His purpose through His Word and Sacraments. It is our sustenance and strength. Thanks be to God for providing all of that to us and so much more.

See you this weekend in church to get your refreshment in the Word and Sacrament so that you will be ready to be bold.... For such a time as this!

- Between April 13, 2019 and May 31, 2019 - \$150.00 per student
- After June 1, 2019 - \$250.00 per student
- Anytime for new families - \$75.00 per student

We request registration fees be paid to EGL by check unless you request to have your registration fee billed to you via TADS. If you would like you to be billed through TADS please email your request to Amy Stroh.

If you are a family that is participating in the Private School Choice Program these above amounts do not apply to you. However, we do ask that you please re-register in Fast Direct for next school year as well as through the Private School Choice Application at <https://apps4.dpi.wi.gov/ChoiceParent/> and provide EGL with the required verification documents.
