SOCIAL MEDIA SAFETY TIP: What is the Yik Yak App? Watch [Parent Guide Video](#)

- "Yik Yak acts like a local bulletin board for your area by showing the most recent posts from other users around you. It allows anyone to connect and share information with others without having to know them."
- "Some students have compared it to a virtual bathroom wall where users post vitriol and hate."
- "Psychologically, Yik Yak actually removes all pretense of being a person with empathy, genuinely connected to other human beings."
- "So it is no wonder that Yik Yak has become the ultimate tool for bullies, especially at the high school level, who want to target another student or a faculty member and — without any consequences, whatsoever — anonymously destroy that person's reputation."

SPECIAL VOTERS ASSEMBLY: The EGL Church Council at its regular meeting on Monday, March 14, approved the work program for the next fiscal year, July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017. That work program now moves forward to the Voters for ratification.
