We are slowly finding our new normal during this abnormal time

Worship – we have been recording on Friday evenings between 5 and 6 P.M. depending on schedules. If you would like to serve as the “congregation” on one of those

Friday nights, please call pastor. We are inviting 6 people a week to be our “congregation” and if you would like to be reader that would be great.



Holy Communion: We have also begun distributing the Lord's Supper on **Sunday mornings from 10 A.M.** until 11 or so. There is no service just a reception of the Sacrament. In order to maintain the guidelines set by the state, we have instituted this procedure:

1. Enter through the south parking lot, lower narthex door, and proceed to the sanctuary. Please stand on the first empty blue line. If there is no line available, you need to return to your car until someone leaves. The state allows only 10 people at a time.
2. The pastor will invite you to come forward, He will hand you a wafer in a small envelope. Take the wafer out and eat it. Drop the envelope in the waste container.
3. He will than hand you an individual cup, drink the wine/grape juice and then drop the cup in the container. If you wish grape juice please inform Pastor, otherwise he will hand you wine.
4. Please leave by door into the education wing and proceed down the ramp/steps.
5. If you need to use the elevator, come up the ramp, take the elevator and stand in the doorway. Pastor will bring communion to you and then you may exit the way you came in.

If you are still not comfortable being in groups, Pastor would be happy to bring communion to you at any time. Please call the church between 9 A.M. and Noon to make arrangements for him to come to you.

Daily Devotion: Pastor Tom is recording a daily devotion that you can listen to by calling the office and entering #24. The devotions will be recorded by 10:00 AM each morning Monday thru Saturday.
