Returning to Worship – Wonderful news! As the Illinois “shelter-in-place” directive moves into Phase 4, it is anticipated that we will be resuming in-person Sunday worship services on June 28th. We will be following the Illinois Department of Health and CDC guidelines, so attendance will be limited to about 60, to allow observance

If we discover that we have more interested in worshipping with us than we can accommodate safely, an 8:30 service will be added. Those interested in attending should contact the church office at 847-253-4839.

Although additional details of the protocols will be forthcoming, please be aware of the following:

- Worshipers will be required to wear a face mask/covering when entering and leaving the church. Face mask/covering will also be required when utilizing the restrooms.
- Greeters, ushers, and communion servers will wear masks and gloves.
- No one should shake hands or hug.
- Seating will be in every third pew; pews that will be available for seating will be marked. Seating spots are marked with blue + and the ends of the pews will also have blue tape on them. These are the only places you should sit.
- Worship folders will be at each available seat and ushers will bring extras as needed to those sitting together because they have been sheltering-in-place together.
- Observance of 6-foot distancing rule must be follow, unless you have sheltered-in-place together.
- Communion: Worshipers will remain in their seats. Communion servers will come to you. Individual cups and individual wafers in coin envelopes will be distributed.
- Offering plates will be at each entrance to the sanctuary.

The pandemic situation continues to be fluid. As new developments arise, services and protocols will be adjusted accordingly. We are investigating the possibility of eventually streaming worship services. Be assured, the contactless methods (worship video, daily devotion, weekly mini-Voice) will continue for those who are not comfortable with in-person contact at this time.
