## “Director of Youth and Family Outreach”

Did you know that a committee of your fellow Faith Lutherans has been developing a job description for a potential “Director of Youth and Family Outreach” (DYFO)? It's been six years since Faith had a staff member to oversee youth and young adult ministry. Your congregational leaders are taking steps to see that this gap in our ministry is addressed! The members of the youth committee are nearly finished with their work on the new job description. The full job description, along with other details for the position such as compensation, will be presented to you at the Summer Voter's Assembly on July 30<sup>th</sup> at 10:15 a.m. **Here are a few highlights from the committee's work:**

- This future staff member will focus upon Youth Ministry, Young Adult Ministry, and Family Ministry. This individual will also help to promote Faith's ministry through social media and other electronic means.

- The majority of the DYFO's efforts will be in the area of Youth Ministry. While the DYFO will have much direct interaction with our youth, it will also be his or her responsibility to recruit and train other members to assist with our Youth Ministry.

- The DYFO will connect with Faith's young adults, college students, and military members. The DYFO will help to develop Bible study and fellowship opportunities for young adults and help to connect college students and military members with Campus Ministries or the ministry of LCMS Military Chaplains.

- An additional area of responsibility will be Family Ministry. The DYFO will work to equip and encourage parents to be the primary influences in their child's/youth's faith formation. The DYFO will also help to arrange Bible study and fellowship opportunities for growth in Christian parenting.

While the youth committee's work is ongoing, hopefully this gives you a sense of what this position could look like! Please contact the youth committee chairman, Ritch Noble, for more details on their work. And please plan to attend the Summer Voter's Assembly on Sunday, July 30<sup>th</sup>, after the 9:00 a.m. service. *Your congregation needs your participation and input!*
