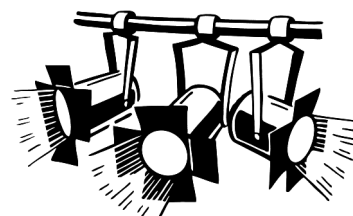

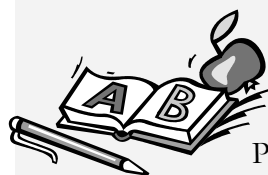


LHSSF One-Act Performance at Memorial

Christ College Church Vocations Scholarship

Is God calling you into church work in the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod? Are you concerned about how you are going to pay for the high cost of college? Concordia University Irvine, for the 2019-2020 school year, is offering qualified LCMS church work students a guaranteed total of \$20,000 per year in institutional aid and an on-campus housing grant of \$6,390. To start the application process, go to www.cui.edu/app. To learn more about the church vocations scholarship, who is qualified, and additional application requirements for church work programs, go to www.cui.edu/churhworkscholarship.

LCEF Scholarship for LCMS High School Seniors

The Lutheran Church Extension Fund is providing \$1,000 scholarships for LCMS high school seniors and college students. Scholarships will be awarded to at least one applicant from each district in the LCEF Central Region. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior or current full-time post-secondary student at an accredited institution with at least one year of courses remaining. Candidates must also be members of a congregation belonging to The Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod located in one of the following LCMS districts: Iowa East, Iowa West, Minnesota North, Minnesota South, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, North Wisconsin, South Dakota or South Wisconsin. **The application deadline is January 31st, 2019.** Applications will not be considered valid unless all material requested is submitted in the online application. Please visit lcefcentral.org/scholarships for more details and for the application.

DAR Scholarship for Military Descendants

The South Dakota State Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution offers an annual \$500 scholarship to direct descendants of United States Military Veterans. Any high school senior or student receiving an accredited high school diploma or GED, who plans to attend an institution of higher learning, is a resident of SD and is the direct descendant of a United States Military Veteran is eligible. For more information, visit the school office. **Application deadline is February 15th, 2018.**

SDES Engineering Scholarships

The Eastern Chapter of the South Dakota Engineering Society (SDES) is currently offering scholarships for high school seniors applying to engineering colleges in South Dakota: \$2,000 Engineering Scholarships for 2019 High School Graduates who will be attending South Dakota Engineering Schools in the Fall of 2019. Students who plan to attend South Dakota School of Mines and Technology or South Dakota State University may apply for the scholarship. Applicants will be judged on national standard test scores, transcripts, extracurricular activities, and answers to questions on the application. Application forms are available in the school office or can be found at www.sdes.org under Student Information. **Completed applications must be postmarked by January 16th, 2019.**

Sioux Falls Area Community Foundation 2019 Scholarships

Bill Barlow “Second Chance” Scholarship

Applicants must be graduating seniors of an alternative school, or of a Sioux Falls area public or private high school, or have earned a GED. Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of no greater than 2.7. **Award: \$2,500; Deadline: March 15.**

Cogley-Buffington Certified Property and Casualty Underwriters Fund

Applicants must be graduating seniors from high schools throughout South Dakota who plan to attend an accredited, four-year college or university. Applicants must demonstrate financial need; have a GPA of 3.5 or higher; participate in extra-curricular and community activities, and demonstrate an interest in and understanding of the role of business in American society. **Award: \$1,000; Deadline: March 15.**

Davenport Evans Scholarship

Applicants must be graduating seniors of high schools in Brookings, Lake, Lincoln, McCook, Minnehaha, Moody, or Turner counties. They must have high academic achievement as demonstrated by cumulative GPA, class rank, and ACT score; plan to attend an accredited four-year college or university in South Dakota; and be involved in school and community activities. Applicants must demonstrate a desire to pursue and meet educational goals. Children and immediate family members of the firm’s partners and employees are not eligible. **Award: \$2,500; Deadline: March 15.**

David L. Profflet Scholarship

Winners of this award must be graduates of a SD high school who plan to attend Augustana University in Sioux Falls. Candidates will have a GPA of 3.0 or higher; demonstrate financial need; and show character traits such as courage, determination, and an ability to overcome adversity. **Award: \$500; Deadline: April 1.**

Fred and Marie Christopherson Scholarship

Applicants who plan to attend a four-year college or university in South Dakota, have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.9 after seven semesters, and have a minimum ACT score of 28 are eligible for this award. **Award: \$3,000; Deadline: March 15.**

Herman and LaVerne Griller Scholarship

Applicants must be graduating seniors of an accredited high school in Minnehaha, Lincoln, Turner, or McCook County who plan to attend an accredited college or university and have a GPA of 3.0 or higher. Applicants must demonstrate financial need. **Award: \$4,500; Deadline: March 15.**

Hovik Family Scholarship (faith-related scholarship)

Applicants must be graduating high school seniors who live in Lincoln County and are members of the Lutheran faith with plans to attend accredited four-year colleges or universities that are affiliated with the Lutheran church. Applicants must also demonstrate financial need and have the ability to achieve academic success. **Award: \$1,000; Deadline: March 15.**

Sioux Falls Area Community Foundation 2019 Scholarships

Independent Insurance Agents of Sioux Falls Scholarship

Applicants for this award must be graduating seniors of Sioux Falls public or private high schools who plan to attend a South Dakota college, university, or technical/vocational institute. Applicants must also demonstrate financial need, which is the key factor in selecting a winner for this award. Additional criteria includes a GPA of 3.0 or higher and an ability to succeed in a chosen field of study. **Award: \$1,000; Deadline: March 15.**

Junior League of Sioux Falls Scholarship

Applicants must be female; reside in Minnehaha or Lincoln Counties; be a graduating seniors from an accredited high school or a home school program; and plan to attend an accredited college, university, community college, vocational school, or technical school (excluding institutions whose academic programs are conducted primarily online or via correspondence). Applicants must have a minimum ACT score of 23 or a minimum SAT score in the math and critical reading components of 1060. **Award: \$750; Deadline: March 15.**

Kiwanis Clubs of Sioux Falls Scholarship

Open to graduating seniors from a Minnehaha or Lincoln County high school who plan to attend a South Dakota college, university, vocational, or technical school. Applicants must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher; an ACT score of 23 or higher; and be a child, grandchild, or stepchild of a Sioux Falls Kiwanis Club member or be a member of a Kiwanis affiliate Key Club in Minnehaha or Lincoln County. Applicant's interest in community service is also a criterion. **Award: \$1,250; Deadline: March 15.**

Mark Bielen Scholarship

Applicants must be graduating seniors of an accredited Sioux Falls area high school in Lincoln or Minnehaha County who plan to attend a college or university, or a vocational or technical school. **Award: \$1,250; Deadline: March 15.**

Ralph and Doris Wallin Scholarship

Applicants must be residents of Minnehaha or Lincoln County who are 25 years old or younger and are enrolling for the first time at an accredited vocational or technical institution in South Dakota or within 250 miles of Sioux Falls. Applicants must have maintained at least a 2.5 GPA for the last three years of the student's high school study. **Award: \$5,500; Deadline: March 15.**

Waneta Drake Miller Edmison Memorial Scholarship

Applicants must be graduating seniors of an accredited high school in Minnehaha, Lincoln, Turner, or McCook county in South Dakota and plan to attend an accredited college, university, community college, vocational school, or technical school. Additionally, applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher and have participated in school and community activities. **Award: \$3,250; Deadline: March 15.**
