

"Holy places" by the Rev. Dr. Meghan Johnston Aelabouni

Physical places often shape our identities, relationships and faith. "Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it," Paul writes. Part of what this means is that faith doesn't just reside in our thoughts or emotions. Faith resides in our whole bodies, and how our bodies "live and move and have our being" in the sacred places where God encounters us. In this Fall 2023 Gather Bible study, written by an ELCA missionary living in Jerusalem, we'll explore what holy places mean, not only for the Holy Land of the Bible, but for each of us, wherever we may be.

September

Holy places: Home

Home can be the place we lay our head and the people we call family. Home can be our community or homeland. Home is also found wherever we truly and fully belong. This month, we consider the complexity and the promise of "home" through the stories of Israel's exile, the ministry of Jesus, and the promises of Revelation.

October

Holy places: Sanctuary

For thousands of years, physical spaces have been set apart for individual prayer and community worship. "Sanctuary" is one word for such spaces. Throughout history, "sanctuary" has also referred to spaces of safety and refuge. If God is everywhere, what is the importance of sanctuary? What can Jesus' teachings and Paul's correspondence with the early church teach us about what sanctuary looks like today?

November

Holy places: Pilgrimage

Pilgrimage, a journey to a sacred place, is a spiritual practice with a long history in Christianity (and many other religions). In the Bible, pilgrimage is not only about the destination, but also about the "holy place" of the journey itself. Considering the journey of the Magi, the walk to Emmaus, and Jesus' arrival in Jerusalem, we'll ponder how pilgrimage can inspire, challenge and transform our faith and our lives.



FELC MAKES QUILTS AND ASSEMBLES BABY CARE,
PERSONAL CARE, AND SCHOOL KITS. THEY ARE SENT TO LWR
EACH SEPTEMBER. PACKING DATE IS EARLY SEPTEMBER.
WATCH FOR MORE DETAILS IN BULLETIN.

Include the following items in each **BABY CARE KIT**:

(Baby clothes should be size 6 months to 24 months)

- Two lightweight cotton t-shirts (no Onesies or snap crotch)
- Two gowns or sleepers (long or short sleeved, no feet)
- Two receiving blankets, between 36" to 52" square
- Four cloth diapers, flat fold preferred
- One jacket, sweater or sweatshirt with hood or cap (up to size 2)
- Two pairs of socks
- One hand towel, dark color recommended
- Two or three bars of gentle soap (equaling 8-9 oz.), in its original wrapping
- Two large diaper or safety pins

Include the following items in each <u>PERSONAL CARE KIT</u>:

- One bath size towel (approx. 52"x27"), dark color recommended (light weight)
- Two or three bars (equaling 8-9 oz.) of soap, any brand, in its original wrapping
- One adult-size toothbrush in its original packaging*
- One sturdy comb, remove packaging
- One metal nail clippers, remove packaging

Packing: Do not add or leave out any items. Wrap all items in the towel and tie securely with ribbons or yarn. Do not enclose any portion in plastic.

^{*}Toothbrush multi-packs may be used by sealing an individual toothbrush in a business envelope; no plastic bags or wrap.

Include the following items in each <u>SCHOOL KIT</u>:

- Four 70-sheet notebooks of wide- or college-ruled paper approximately 8" X 10 1/2", do not include loose-leaf paper
- One 30-centimeter ruler, or a ruler with centimeters on one side and inches on the other
- One blunt scissors (safety scissors with embedded steel blades work well)
- One pencil sharpener
- Five new, unsharpened #2 pencils with erasers; secure together with a rubber band
- Five black or blue ball point pens (no gel ink), secured together with a rubber band
- One eraser, approximately 2 1/2" long
- One box of 16 or 24 crayons
- One sturdy cloth bag approximately14"x17" with shoulder straps—no backpacks.
