Health update:

As many of you know last October, we learned that Jeancarlos has an arteriovenous malformation (AVM) a specific type of brain aneurysm. In November 2017 Jeancarlos underwent a successful embolization of the aneurysm. While it was successful it was not enough to cut off the blood flow or fully reduce the AVM to a safe size. In February, Jeancarlos had a second embolization. It was a success there were no complications during surgery and the doctor was very



pleased with the results. He has been able to shrink the aneurysm to a sixth of its original size. The doctor now believes that Jeancarlos is a candidate for radio-surgery (a form of concentrated and specifically directed radiation which would destroy the malformation without traditional surgery.) We must wait 3 months at which point another MRI will show if there have been any changes in the shape and size of the malformation. If there are no changes then in June we will seek the final step in Jeancarlos' treatment with the radiosurgery. We are blown away by the success of this embolization and the new recommendations from the doctor. Thank you to all who have been praying with us during this process. The Lord has truly worked a miracle in our lives.

We have been faithfully working over the last few months within Castillo Fuerte to share the bile with the kids and mothers. The kids have been going through the bible stories starting Genesis. The mothers have been coming to bible study and chapel in the evenings. A small group of mothers seems to be forming who are truly interested in receiving the Gospel. Krochet Kids has also celebrated another victory with the graduation of another group of ladies from their program. It is a joy to share with in ministry changing the lives of families both physically and spiritually.

Hello everybody, This month using material from CPTLN (Lutheran Hour Ministries) we had a good time with women in San Juan de Lurigancho and Los Olivos. In San Juan de Lurigancho, we had a bible study about where is Jesus when we suffer and we made earrings out of fosil and sea shells. In Los Olivos, we had a biblie study, and we share many experienses about where is God when life is difficult.
