

BELT OF TRUTH

God's true Word helps us do what's right (Ephesians 6:14a)

Read: Daniel 3 = A fiery furnace

Talk: Ask these questions and discuss together

- Why wouldn't Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego bow down and worship the statue? What Bible truth does that go against?
- Why do you think Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego were brave enough to stand up for the truth?
- How did knowing God's true Word help them do what was right?
- What is a truth that you need to stand up for?
- What makes it hard to stand up for the truth?
- How is God's Word our source of truth?

Activity: Gather some duct tape (colored works best) and two D-rings. Follow the instructions on the next page to create and label a Belt of Truth.

(Be sure to keep the "Belt of Truth" in a safe place for future lessons to use as a review tool and add other pieces of armor to it.)



Pray: Lord, help us remember the belt of truth and the power that truth has to help us make good choices. Thank you that your words to us are always true. In Jesus' name, Amen.

THE BELT OF TRUTH

Duct Tape Craft for Kids

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

2 D-rings

2 pieces of Tape A (blue) - 1 short, and 1 long and fat

2 pieces of Tape B (orange) - 1 short, and 1 long and thin

STEP 1:

Place the 2 D-rings together and fold the short piece of Tape A in half around them.



STEP 2:

Wrap the short piece of Tape B around the short piece of Tape A.



STEP 3:

Turn the long, fat piece of Tape A so the sticky side is up. Lay the D-rings on the end of the tape.



STEP 4:

Lay the long, thin piece of Tape B in the middle of the Tape B piece so that the two sticky sides are together.



STEP 5:

Fold the two sides of the Tape A piece down onto Tape B. Trim the other end so it will slip through the buckle easily (the 2 D-rings).



STEP 6:

Turn the belt over and use a marker to write "The Belt of Truth" on it. Then put it on and enjoy!
